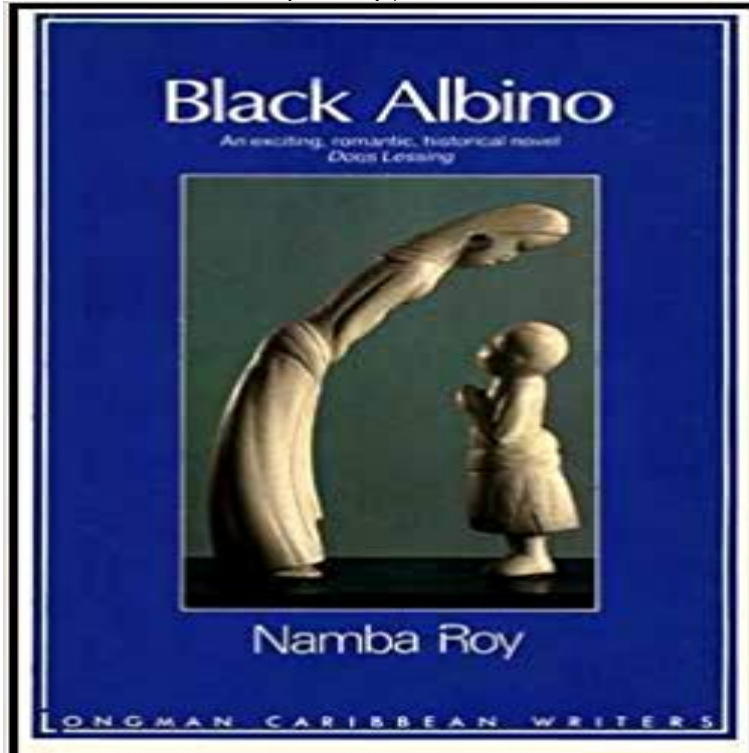


Black Albino (Longman Caribbean Writer Series)
