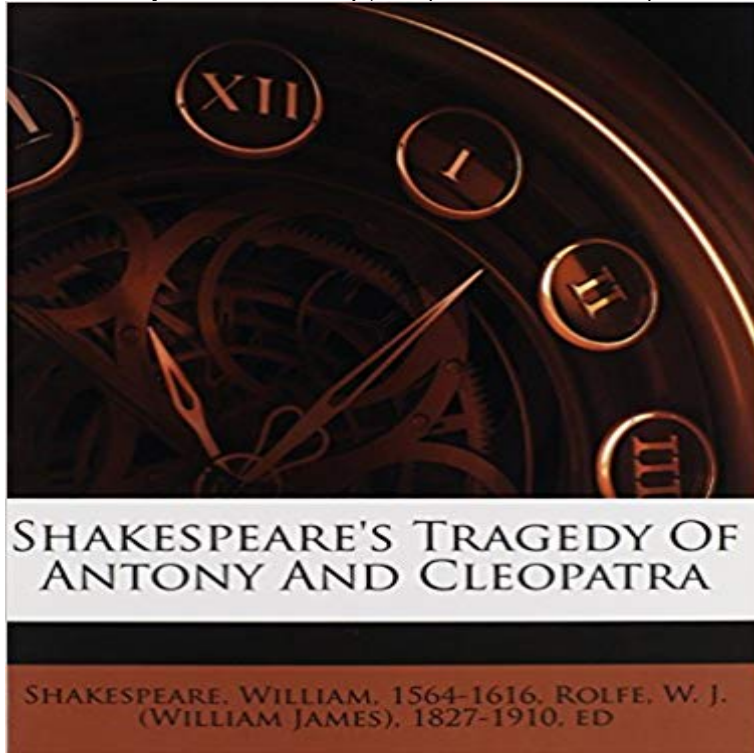


# Shakespeares Tragedy Of Antony And Cleopatra
