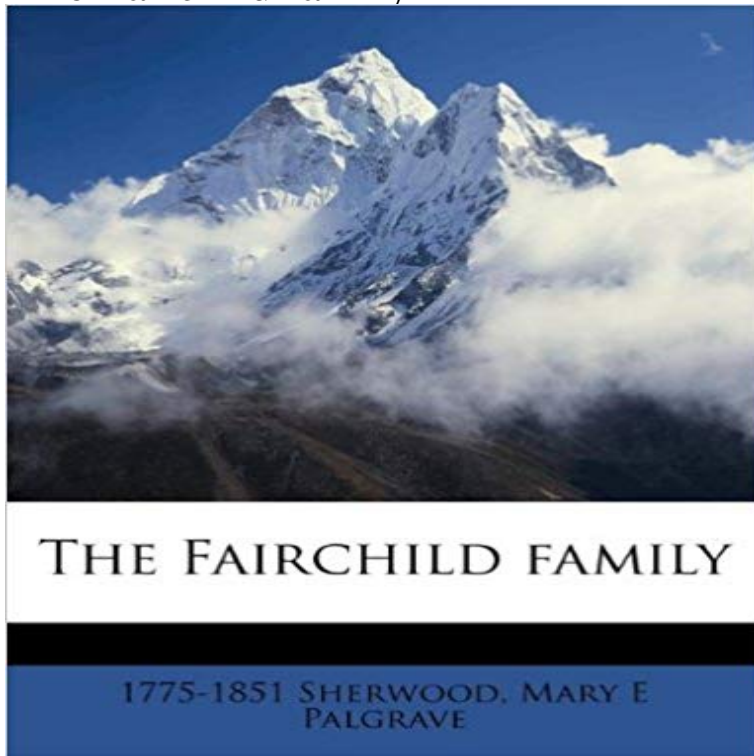


The Fairchild family
