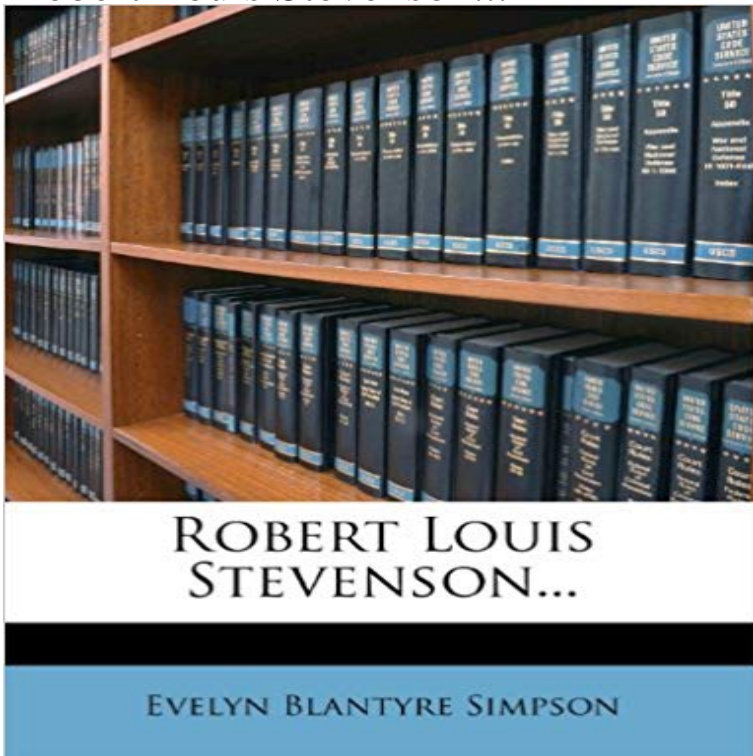


# Robert Louis Stevenson...
