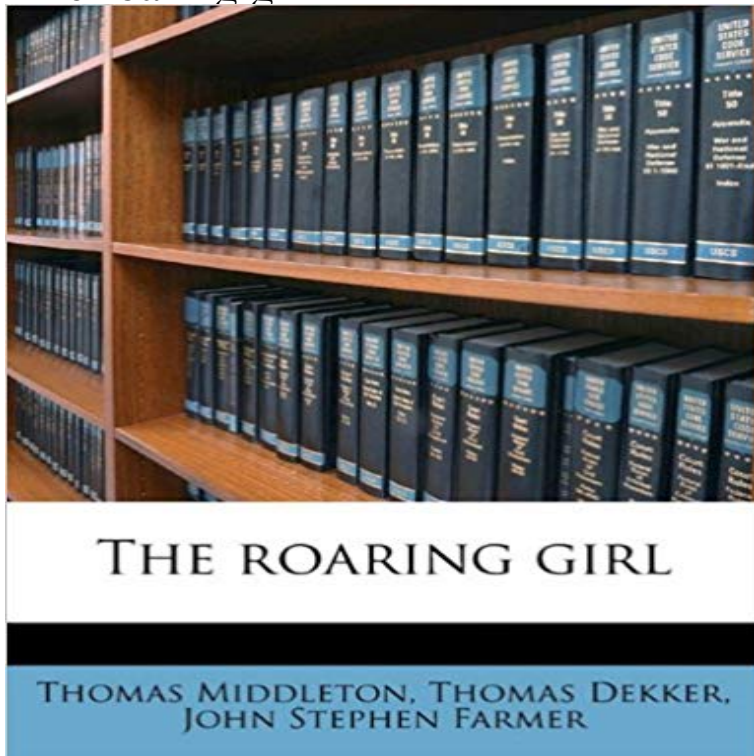


The roaring girl
